Lolium westerwoldicum

- Autumn as well as spring sowing
- Superior with several cuts
- Excellent rust tolerance
- Very good lodging tolerance



More than one cut

Most annual ryegrasses are suited for one or two cuts.
AKTIV shows better persistency, often allowing 3-5 cuts.

Three quality parameters to enhance forage quality and preserve yield:

Excellent rust tolerance. It preserves the yielding capacity as well as the feeding quality and palatability.

Lodging tolerance. Less soil contamination, easier drying for silage or hay, and of course much better feeding quality.

Diploid = Faster drying and better conservation.

Seasonal adaptation:

AKTIV can be sown in the autumn as well as in the spring.

Mixtures:

AKTIV can be sown pure or in mixtures with other fast growing varieties and legumes.

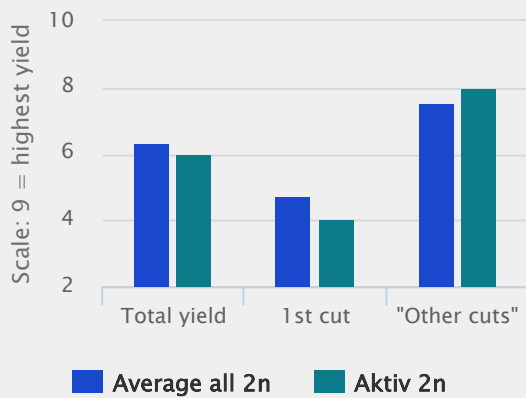

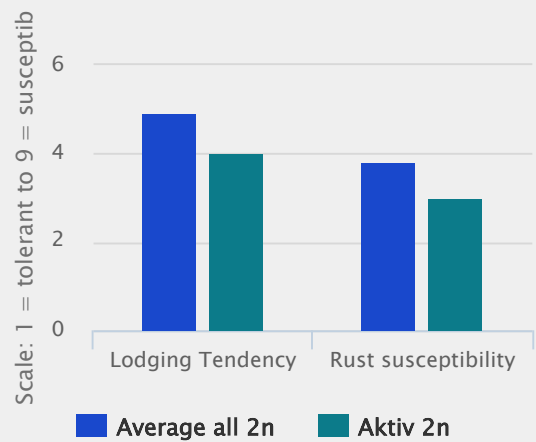
Drymatter yield
