

NEOSO

Festuca arundinacea

- Late heading with early spring start = large spring window
- High DM yield in spring, summer & total
- High protein content and protein yield
- Palatable with softer leaves



Dry matter production

NEOSO is very productive throughout the growing season from early spring to late autumn.

Large spring window

For a late heading variety, the growth starts very early in spring leading to a very long period with high quality grass and several options for grazing and conservation options.

Soft leaves

NEOSO has soft leaves for improved palatability when used for grazing.

High protein content

With a high protein content and a high dry matter yield the yield of protein/ha is very good and improves self-sufficiency with less concentrates needed from external purchase.

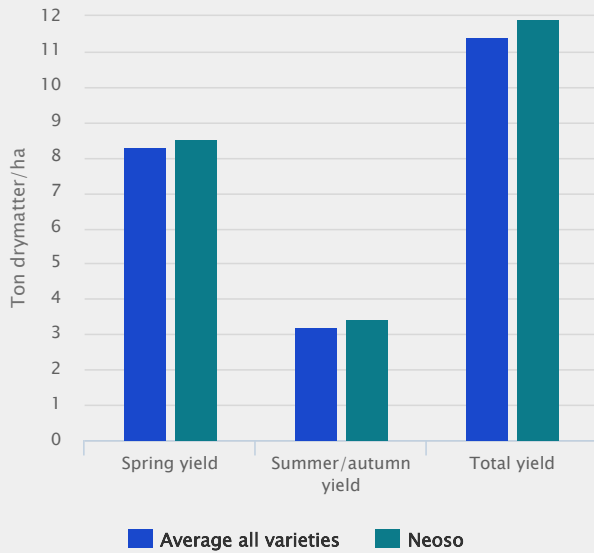
